How to become a Stable Partner



Thank you for showing interesting in becoming a Sales Partner. Please find below a breakdown of the process and details of the next steps.

INITIAL INFORMATION

As part of our regulatory requirements we will ask some questions about your business and the people involved. This is a simple and quick process for our partners, but one that can take a few days to complete by Stable.

COMMISSION

The level of commission is agreed in advance as a percentage (%) of Premium. You can track your commission in the Stable online dashboard 24/7 and your commission is paid each month along with a detailed statement.

DISTRIBUTION AGREEMENT

We will then send you a standard Sales Partner agreement which is a contract between your company and Stable that clearly explains how it works and the responsibilities of both parties.

ACCESS TO PLATFORM

Once the Sales Partner agreement is signed you will receive an email containing your username, password and platform link with two working days.

ONBOARDING SESSION

A member of the Stable team will be in touch and, where possible, share screens to take you through the process of generating your Stable Quote Engine. This is the link your farmers will use to generate a quote. We will also walk you through every aspect of the system and answer any operational questions you may have. You can also request a member of the Stable team to come and talk to your team at your office.


